The Impact of Aging on Cerebrovascular Reserve and Balance

Aging affects multiple organ systems and interactions among them. Cerebrovascular reserve that refers to brain's ability to increase brain perfusion in response to increased neuronal activity and metabolic demands also declines with aging. As a result older people may have inadequate brain perfusion during standing, walking or performing a dual task (e.g. walking and talking), and increased risk for falls.
